### Dundonnell Wind Farm– Construction update #3

The Tilt Renewables team has commenced construction of the \$560 million Dundonnell Wind Farm located approximately 23km north-east of Mortlake, in the Western District of Victoria. Work by AusNet Services on the transmission line and substation, is also about to commence.

In regards to the wind farm construction, work has now commenced on Woorndoo-Streatham road with a work crew stripping the existing seal and re-shaping the road formation. Traffic control is in place and the speed limit temporarily reduced through the works zone. The upgrades are expected to take about 12 weeks to complete.

Native vegetation flagging continued this week to ensure native vegetation is clearly identified well ahead of the earthworks progress, this will prevent works from encroaching these areas.

The satellite construction compound has been set up for the external road upgrade works and additional plant is continuing to mobilise to site for commencement of the quarry next week. We do not anticipate any impact on traffic conditions whilst the equipment is arriving but please be mindful when you are driving through the area.

As for the transmission lines, secondary consents including the Traffic Management Plan and Environmental Management Plan are now endorsed by the respective authorities. AusNet and the construction contractor Downer have commenced mobilisation ahead of the impending commencement of construction.
