Tilt Renewables brings a fresh approach to energy generation. We aim to be the leading developer and owner of renewable energy generation in Australia and New Zealand. We tilt with the wind, and towards the sun to rebalance energy generation. We tilt for good. We tilt for the future.

We are a dual New Zealand and Australian listed owner, operator and developer of a number of established wind farms and an extensive wind and solar development pipeline.

Originally part of the New Zealand based Trustpower Ltd that had its beginnings in 1924 as a local power authority and has been active in Australia since 2001, Tilt Renewables was established in October 2016 as the result of the demerger from Trustpower Limited. Tilt Renewables has had a strong track record of developing wind assets in both Australia and New Zealand and the demerger allows better opportunities for Tilt Renewables to raise capital to deliver our extensive development pipeline.

Tilt Renewables will shift its energy skywards into potential investment in solar generation, in support of the Australian Government's Renewable Energy Target (RET) of 33,000GWh by 2020.





We have extensive experience in renewable energy development, construction & operation.

We own and operate seven wind farms located in Australia and New Zealand.

With a total of 307 turbines and an installed operating capacity of 582MW (approximately 11% market share of installed wind capacity in Australasia).

Our wind farms include Snowtown (South Australia's largest and Australia's second largest wind farm) and the Tararua Wind Farm (New Zealand's largest wind farm).

Tilt Renewables also has a substantial development pipeline of 9 further wind farm and solar projects across Australia and New Zealand, with over 2000MW of development projects across WA, SA, Vic, NSW and QLD.

We have strong and supportive shareholder base, including a New Zealand based infrastructure investment company Infratil (51%) and the Tauranga Energy Consumer Trust (26.8%). The remaining shares are held by institutional and retail investors.

Other local community support initiatives included the sponsorship of the concrete for the Snowtown skate park, installation of the big blade tourist attraction and contributing towards the installation of underground irrigation for Snowtown Primary School's school oval. Local club and community sponsorships, native vegetation planting and cultural heritage initiatives, as well as coordination with the County Fire Service have all enabled us to gain a genuine understanding of and connection with the local community.
