

Weekly Construction Update - #10

Dundonnell Wind Farm

Voorndoo-Streatham Rd



The Tilt Renewables team has commenced construction of the \$560 million Dundonnell Wind Farm located approximately 23km north-east of Mortlake in the Western District of Victoria. AusNet Services have mobilised to the Mortlake industrial area and have commenced work on the 38km of 220kV transmission line and substation.

Construction activities on the Wind Farm are continuing with public road works progressing along the eight kilometres of Voorndoo-Streatham Road. The first three kilometres have now been sealed, pavement placed up to 4.5 kilometres and gravel delivered from the 4.5 kilometres to six kilometres mark. Additional construction is continuing along Track 1 inside the wind farm boundary from the site entry towards the quarry.



Over at the **Quarry**, crushing and screening of rock material has continued, with the high quality material being used as construction material within the wind farm boundary.

It was a fairly boring week over on the **Transmission Line** works, with transmission pole foundations bored and poured. However over at the substation site activity has ramped up with clearing and earthworks commencing.
