

Rye Park Wind Farm Construction Update



Week Commencing 13 December 2021

Construction Updates are released fortnightly and include a summary of construction works undertaken and a look-ahead of upcoming works.

The Tilt Renewables team has officially commenced construction of the Rye Park Wind Farm. The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) was notified and construction commenced on 1st December 2021.

Tilt Renewables construction contractor Zenviron (and their subcontractors) continue to mobilise staff and equipment resources to the Project and have commenced construction of the three site entry points along with the commencement of the upgrade of Dalton Rd (between the southern access point and Cooks Hill Rd).

The team is also continuing with pre-construction minor works including construction of the access to the onsite temporary compound facilities and the temporary compound bench. The construction contractor has also been busy undertaking ecological pre-clearance surveys of the public roads and current work areas along with flagging of environmentally sensitive areas such as potential habitat trees and areas of native vegetation.

On 1 December we held a drop-in session for Yass Street, Rye Park residents to discuss designs of the Yass Street upgrade, managing access to driveways and measures the Project is undertaking to minimise impacts to street trees within the village. Early next year we will hold a workshop with the community to further discuss beautification plans for Yass Street. The CCC met the night before with plenty of constructive conversations on various aspects of the Project. When available, the minutes for this meeting will be posted on the Project website. If you have comments you would like raised at the next CCC please let us know, or contact one of the members directly. Meetings will be held every second month during construction.

The Project has also had its first visit from DPIE's Compliance Team Leader which included constructive discussions on project traffic management including vehicle routes, traffic control and general site compliance, followed by an inspection of the current working areas. Hilltops Council have been conducting road works on Dalton Road between Rye Park and the Shire boundary. This has involved heavy plant on Dalton Road including haul truck movements through Rye Park village and along the local road network.
